

TROOP ONE PERMISSION SLIP
Old Portage Klondike at Camp Manatoc on February 1 - 3, 2013
Permission slips and money are due no later than Tuesday, January 22

EVENT: Aloha! And welcome to the 2013 Winter Klondike, put on by the Old Portage District. We plan to have a spectacular time this year, competing in the annual Klondike Derby and tenting outside in the dead of winter (with plenty of snow, if the weather cooperates). What is a Klondike Derby, you ask? The Klondike Derby is a winter camping and Outdoor Skills competition. Each competing patrol needs a Klondike sled that uses scout power to pull it. Patrols will load the sleds with their patrol equipment and pull them through the competition course stopping at each competition station. Some events will be competitive and some will be instructional. Each event will test and time patrols on their teamwork, scout spirit, winter camping skills, Scouting knowledge and problem solving ability.

GEAR: Each scout must be in full Class A uniform and *wearing his boots* for the car trip to and from the campout. Cold weather clothing and gear are required for this campout. The weather could be wet and rainy, or snowy and very cold, so be prepared. Layers are important. Bring extra clothes and socks. **Cotton is bad**; synthetics and wool are preferred. Waterproof boots or snow boots are recommended. We are sleeping in tents, so your sleeping bag should be rated at 20° Fahrenheit (preferably lower). Adding a fleece blanket inside your sleeping bag is a good idea. If you do not have a cold weather sleeping bag, ask about using a spare one at a Troop meeting.

Boots are a requirement for all Troop One campouts. Come prepared for all types of weather.
