

TROOP ONE PERMISSION SLIP
Mohican Wilderness, July 5 - 7, 2013

*Permission slips and money are due no later than Tuesday, June 18
(please try to return them by June 11 to facilitate our planning)*

EVENT: In July, we will visit the Mohican Wilderness and enjoy the beautiful Mohican River. This is one of the most fun campouts of the year... an annual standard for the Troop. We will canoe the river (5 miles) and tube the river (2 miles), followed by a bunch of other activities at the camp (hayride, archery, project adventure, games in the rec hall, putt putt, and the 1890 rec barn). This year, there is also be an option to kayak the river, instead of canoeing (with leader permission, if you have the BSA Kayaking Award).

To participate in canoeing or kayaking, **you must have a current BSA Swim Test** with a rating of Swimmer or Beginner. Beginners must be in the front of a canoe with a strong Swimmer who is highly skilled in canoeing. Only Swimmers may participate in tubing.

COST: \$30 per person, \$20 if not canoeing or tubing (make checks payable to Boy Scout Troop ONE)

LEAVING: Friday, July 5, 2013 (plan to arrive at First Baptist Church **by 6:15 pm**)

RETURNING: Sunday, July 7, 2013 (estimated return time: **11:00 am**)
Scouts will call you upon returning to the church. If your Scout has another commitment within 2 hours of our return time, please indicate it on the permission slip below and discuss with Scoutmaster Myers.

GEAR: Each Scout must be in full Class A uniform & wearing his boots for the car trip to and from the campout. Scouts should pack to stay dry and comfortable for outdoor activities (that means RAIN GEAR, extra clothes & socks, and a water bottle or camelback). Also bring a swimsuit, a towel, and closed-toe footgear that can get wet (e.g., sandals, water shoes, crocs -- no flip flops); footgear is required in the canoe. Sunscreen is recommended.
GO bags are a standard requirement for every campout (<http://trooponeakron.org/gobag.html>).

Boots are a requirement for all Troop One campouts. Come prepared for all types of weather.
