

TROOP ONE PERMISSION SLIP
New Scout Induction Weekend at Camp Manatoc on February 28 – March 2, 2014

Permission slips and money are due no later than Tuesday, February 11th

EVENT: This will be our annual induction ceremony for new scouts joining Troop One. See <http://trooponeakron.org/whats happening.html> for more details.

We will not only induct new scouts, we will also host a Search and Rescue Incident Command Event with the Ohio Search Dog Association. This will be a great event for all scouts working on emergency preparedness and looks to be an exciting time for all those attending. New Scouts will spend the night in the cabin with their new troop. Older scouts need to be prepared to camp in tents.

COST: \$18.00 per person (make checks payable to Boy Scout Troop ONE)
\$10.00 for new Scouts
\$5.00 for dinner guests only (Families of new scouts eat free)

LEAVING: Friday, February 28, 2014 (plan to arrive at First Baptist Church **by 6:15 pm**)

RETURNING: Sunday, March 2, 2014
New Scouts will need to be picked up at Forester Cabin at 9:00 AM sharp.
All Others estimated return time: **11:00 am** at the First Baptist Church
Scouts will call you upon returning to the church. If your Scout has another commitment within 2 hours of our return time, please indicate it on the permission slip below and discuss with Scoutmaster Myers.

WHERE: **Forester cabin, Tent camping. Camp Manatoc** 1065 Truxell Road, Peninsula, OH 44264. Scoutmaster Myers cell phone number: (330) 801-6034

GEAR: Each scout must be in full Class A uniform and *wearing his boots* for the car trip to and from the campout. Cold weather clothing and gear are required for this campout. The weather could be wet and rainy, or snowy and very cold, so be prepared. Layers are important. Bring extra clothes and socks. **Cotton is bad**; synthetics and wool are preferred. Waterproof boots or snow boots are recommended. We are sleeping in tents, so your sleeping bag should be rated at 20° Fahrenheit or lower. Adding a fleece blanket inside your sleeping bag is a good idea. If you do not have a cold weather sleeping bag, ask about using a spare one at a Troop meeting.

Boots are a requirement for all Troop One campouts. Come prepared for all types of weather.
