WHO: We need Scouts who want to plan an exciting 2012 -2013 calendar and enjoy the activities at East Harbor State Park! Families are invited to join in the adventure, and see the number one troop at its best. This is the only family campout of the year. Scouts will live and eat in their own patrol campsite and save family time for later during "free" time. Families, not including their scouts, will camp and eat with the Java Patrol, the adult patrol. Families should avoid their campsites to allow the boys to succeed on their own.

WHAT: Come out for a fun weekend. This is our Annual Planning Conference (Troop votes on Saturday morning on the 2012-2013 Calendar). You can take or rent a bicycle in the park. You must talk to an adult who agrees to carry your bike on or in their vehicle. Helmets and locks required. A few bikes can be rented there for \$10/day or \$2/hour (limited numbers available). Swimming on the beach if the weather is GREAT and there is no advisory. If we do not swim, we can bike, hike or hang out. In the evening we will play mini golf. Bring some extra cash for snacks at Island Adventures. Don't forget to pack your swim suit and towel!

The ANNUAL PLANNING CONFERENCE will be held where the scouts will vote on the entire program year as presented by their patrol leaders' conference (PLC). This is the last chance to influence the troop year.

COST: Just \$27.00 per person, which covers food, camping fees, and fun filled activities at East Harbor State Park.

LEAVING WHEN: Friday, September 14, 2012 all drivers and scouts must arrive at First Baptist Church by 6:15 pm on Friday! We plan to leave no later than 7:00 pm.

RETURNING WHEN: We will return to First Baptist Church during the late morning on Sunday, September 16, 2012. Scouts will call you upon returning to the church. Estimated time of return is 11:30 pm. If your Scout has another commitment within 2 hours of our return time, please indicate it on the face of the permission slip and discuss with Scoutmaster Myers.

GEAR: Each scout must be in full Class A uniform & wearing his boots for the car trip to and from the campout. Scouts should pack to stay dry and comfortable for outdoor activities (that means RAIN GEAR, extra clothes & socks, and a water bottle or camelback.

Boots are a requirement for all Troop One campouts.
Come prepared for all types of weather. BRING RAIN GEAR!
